Assessment State Mandated	Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.59, require that all English learners be assessed in grades K–12 in English language proficiency. ACCESS for ELLs (ACCESS) and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs (Alternate ACCESS) developed by the multi-state WIDA Consortium are used to meet this federal requirement. ACCESS is an English language proficiency accountability assessment based on the WIDA English Language Development Standards.	*The Listening and Reading tests are adaptive tests that contain multiple-choice and technology enhanced items. The Speaking Test consists of speaking prompts delivered online; students respond by speaking into the microphone of their headsets and their responses are recorded and sent for scoring by DRC. The Writing Test contains a set of tasks to which students respond. Alternate ACCESS tests will be administered the same days as other ACCESS tests	ACCESS Listening Reading Writing Speaking Measures Language Proficiency	Kindergarten The domains of listening, reading, speaking, and writing are assessed within the context of two stories.
